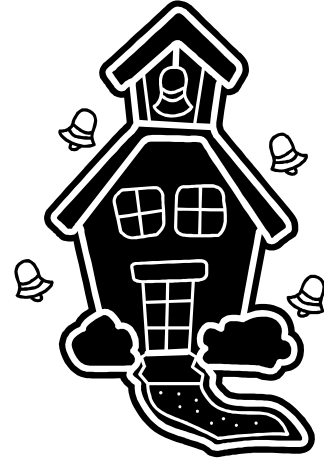

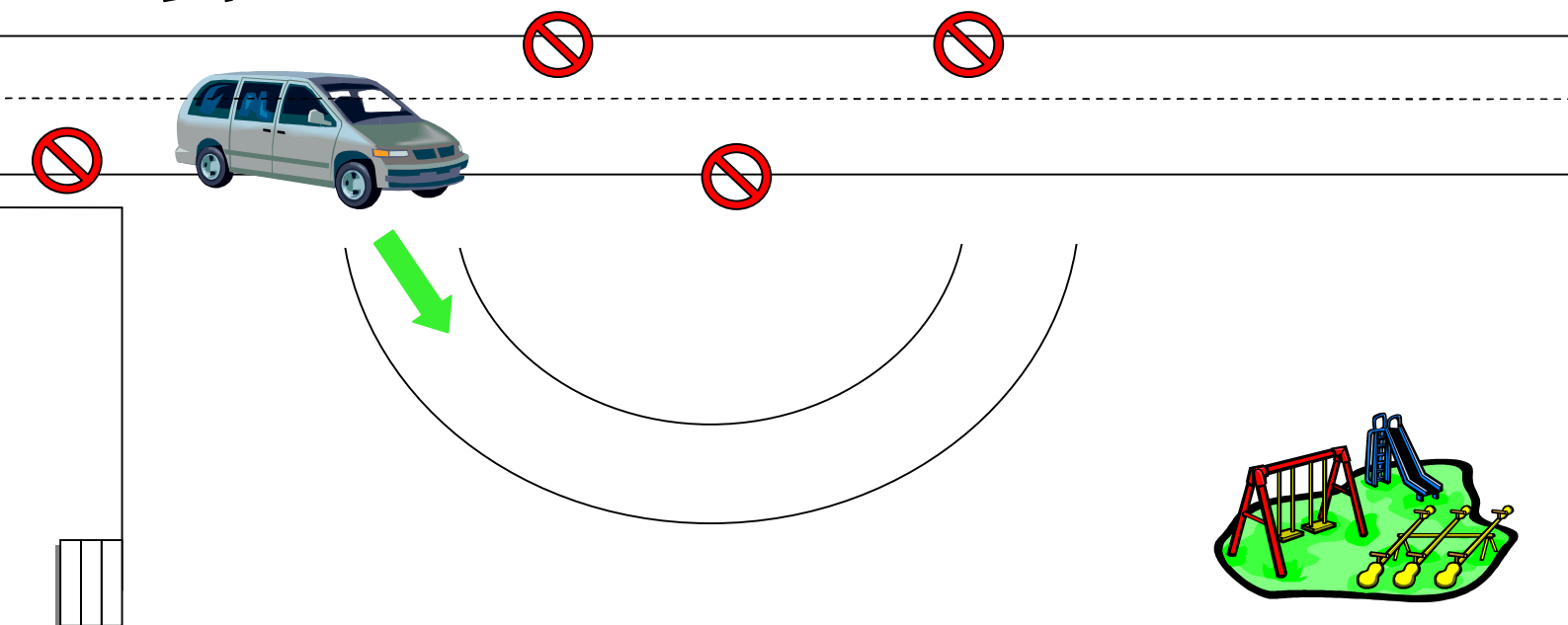


(On Wednesdays, Faith Formation students arrive for class, so our students are dismissed a few minutes earlier.)
