The Adopt-A-Teacher program is a chance for KCSS families to express their appreciation for everything the KCSS staff does!! This is how the program works:

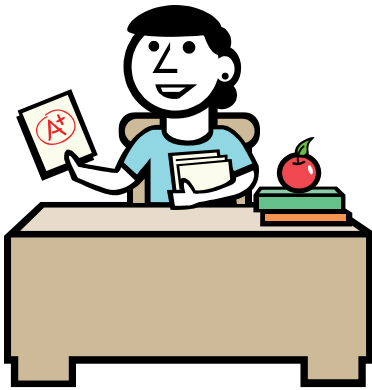
1. You may sign up for as many staff persons as you want.

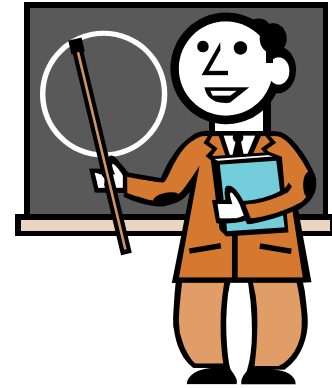
