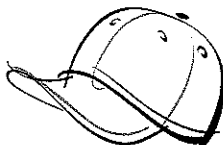

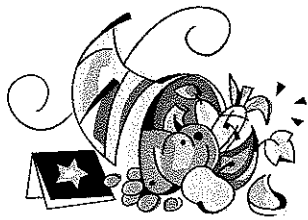

Hot Lunch & Sandwich Volunteers

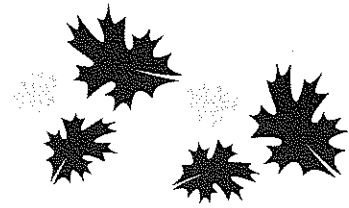

ATTENTION: Family members are welcome to eat with their child/ren. You **MUST** call the kitchen the day before you plan to eat. Thank you.

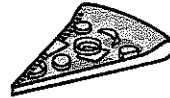
