This summer we have been working hard to continue to improve our school and listen to your suggestions. One thing we heard frequently over the last two years was regarding the amount of a papers being sent home in the "Brown Envelope." We have spent this last year considering the best way to solve this problem for families. Beginning this year, all the information sent from the school will be posted on the KCSS website, [www.kcssonline.org](http://www.kcssonline.org).

This solution offers our families the opportunity to get the information you need online. Families will only have to print out the information they need, not the entire packet. We hope this will eliminate excessive paper use and redundancy of copies for families with students in both schools.

Flyers from community organizations that they have run off and given to us will be sent home with the students in their regular homework folder. We will try to send these papers home on Thursdays if possible. Field trip permission forms will be sent home as well.

On Thursday afternoons, we will post the brown envelope information. It should be available for you to read first thing Friday morning. To access this information go to our website. On the left side of the web page, select "Weekly News." A page will come up with a weekly date for every school week this year. Select the date of the materials you are interested in viewing and click on it. The information for St. Aloysius Campus will appear first. Families with students in Holy Cross only can scroll down until they see a title page with Holy Cross on it. Information will be kept online for the entire year.

Families that cannot access our website should contact the school. If you need assistance learning how to use the "Weekly News," please contact school, we would be happy to help you.



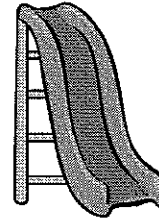

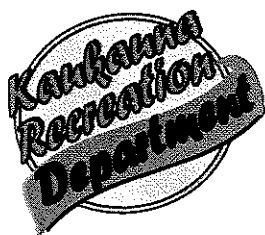

### **FALL DANCE**

**Resident sign-up starts August 14, School District Residents sign up starts August 21 and Non-Resident sign-up is August 23 starting at 8:00 am.** Dance fees are \$65.00 for residents and \$125.00 for school district residents and \$150.00 for non-residents. Registration is limited and will

be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. The program starts the week of September 10 and runs through the winter ending with a three-day dance revue. The classes are once a week, half-hour sessions.

Classes offered are Tap, Jazz, Ballet, Irish, Tumbling, Lyrical and/or Hip-Hop. For tumbling, ballet, and tap lessons, students must be 4 years old by Sept. 1, 2007. For jazz lessons, students must be 5 years old by Sept. 1, 2007. For Irish Dance, students must be 9 years old by Sept. 1, 2007 and have tap experience. Likewise, there is a minimum of 10 students necessary to hold the Irish class. If we do not have enough students we will refund money. For hip-hop lessons, students must be 8 years old by Sept. 1, 2007. For lyrical dance, students must be 11 years old by Sept. 1, 2007. **Please use the level letter to select the appropriate class, if you have not received a level letter, please ask us to help place the student in class.**

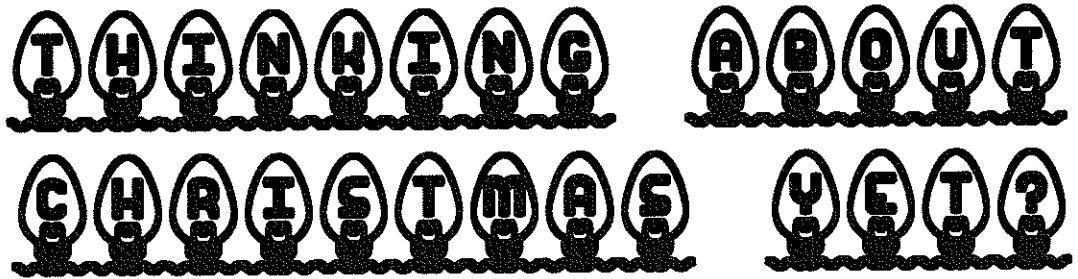

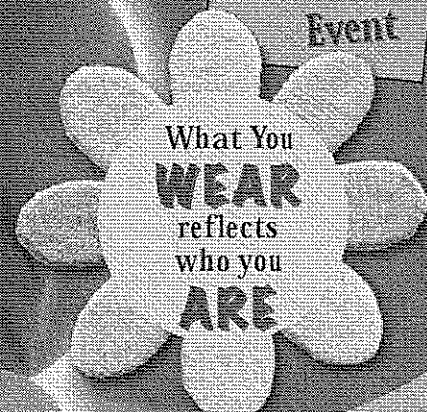

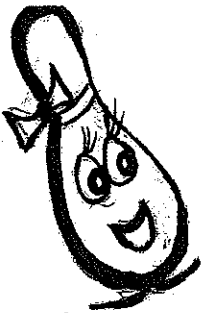
