- ▶ **Payments:** All Payments are due on tryout day (Checks payable to "Kaukauna Boys Hoops Club")

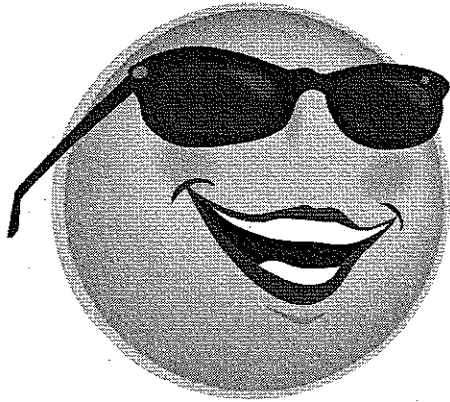

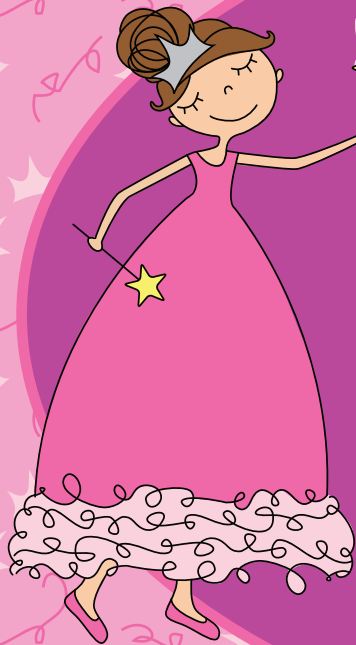
