2009 Kaukauna Recreation Department Girls Fastpitch Softball League

The Kaukauna Recreation Department is accepting registrations for a girl's summer fastpitch softball league. All girls residing in the Kaukauna Area School District and currently in 2nd through 8th grade are eligible to participate. There is a \$40.00 registration fee, which includes a league visor. **The REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2009.**

The league will be played on weekday late afternoons and evenings at Horseshoe Valley Park ball diamonds. There will be three divisions (2nd and 3rd grade, 4th and 5th grade, and 6th, 7th, and 8th grade). It is our intent to have the 2nd and 3rd grade division play on Tuesdays, the 4th and 5th grade division play on Wednesdays, and the 6th through 8th grade division play on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Depending upon the amount of teams in each division, there may be some times where teams may have to play on a different night than stated above.

The goals and objectives of this league are to give all participants an equal opportunity to develop their playing skills. The coaches will emphasize skill development and good sportsmanship. All players will have an opportunity to play a minimum of three innings in each game. The league will be coached and supervised by adult volunteers.

Our goal is to provide the most possible competitive balance within each division. This year, we will not redraft every player. **Girls who played last year and are staying within their division do not have to come to the skills evaluation. These girls will remain on the team that they played on last summer. Only girls new to the program or girls moving up a division are to attend the skills evaluation.** Skills evaluation and team selection will be at the River View Middle School Gymnasium as follows:

- All 2nd grade girls and any 3rd grade girl who did not play last summer: Saturday, March 21 at 9:00 a.m.
- All 4th grade girls and any 5th grade girl who did not play last summer: Saturday, March 21 at 11:00 a.m.
- All 6th grade girls and any 7th or 8th grade girl who did not play last summer: Saturday, March 21 at 1:00 p.m.

League play is scheduled to begin the week of May 11th. The league tournament dates are as follows: 2nd & 3rd Grade Division - July 6, 7, & 8; 4th & 5th Grade Division - July 13, 14 & 15; and 6th, 7th & 8th Grade Division - July 20, 21, & 22. All teams will participate in the tournament.

Prior to the start of the season, each player is encouraged to purchase a pair of black team pants or plain black sports shorts, which will be theirs to keep at the end of the season. A team jersey (top) will be available for league play courtesy of local sponsors for all the girls. *Please Note: The jersey must be returned to their coach at the end of the season.*

Softball Clinic for all Interested Adults

Please Consider Coaching

If you have ever wanted to coach and teach girls softball, this year is an excellent opportunity. With the three divisions (2nd and 3rd grade, 4th and 5th grade, and 6th, 7th and 8th) grade we are in need of coaches. Please know that we will help any and all adults (age 18 or older) interested in coaching by placing you in the program at a place that matches your interest (i.e., with your daughter) and with your level of expertise.

Each of our teams will have two co-coaches to share the responsibilities. We believe that the girl's fastpitch softball program is very collaborative and we work with each other to improve our players and the program. With this in mind, we ask you to give strong consideration to being a girl's softball co-coach.

The time commitment for being a co-coach includes the following:

- Attending the draft/skills evaluation for 2 hours on a Saturday in March.
- Holding one to two practices per week April - May until the season starts.
- Practicing one-time per week during the season starting mid-May through mid-July.
- Attending games mid-May through mid-July on average one time per week.
- Being in charge of equipment and the team jerseys for your team.

Qualities needed to co-coach include:

- Enjoy working with young people.
- Practice an upbeat, enthusiastic approach to teaching girls softball.
- Modeling a positive attitude to parents and players.
- Want to serve others.
- Organized.

In order to further assist anyone interested in coaching, **there will be a coaching clinic held on Saturday, April 25 from 8:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. at Bayorgeon Field #2.** New and veteran coaches are invited to attend this session put on by KHS varsity girl's softball coach, Tim Roehrig, and his varsity girl's softball team. Emphasis will be placed on fundamentals, skills, and drills.

If you want to coach but are reluctant because of your limited background or knowledge of the game, or if you currently do coach softball and want to learn techniques to help you better teach and coach your players, the clinic is designed for you. Even if you want to learn and know the correct fundamentals to teach and help your own daughter, but do not want to coach at this time, you are invited to attend.

We encourage you to take advantage of the free opportunity to improve yourself, our players and our Kaukauna Girls Softball program.

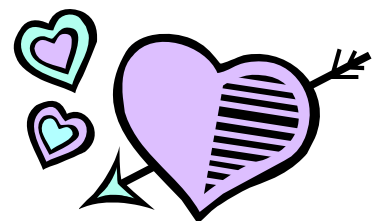
