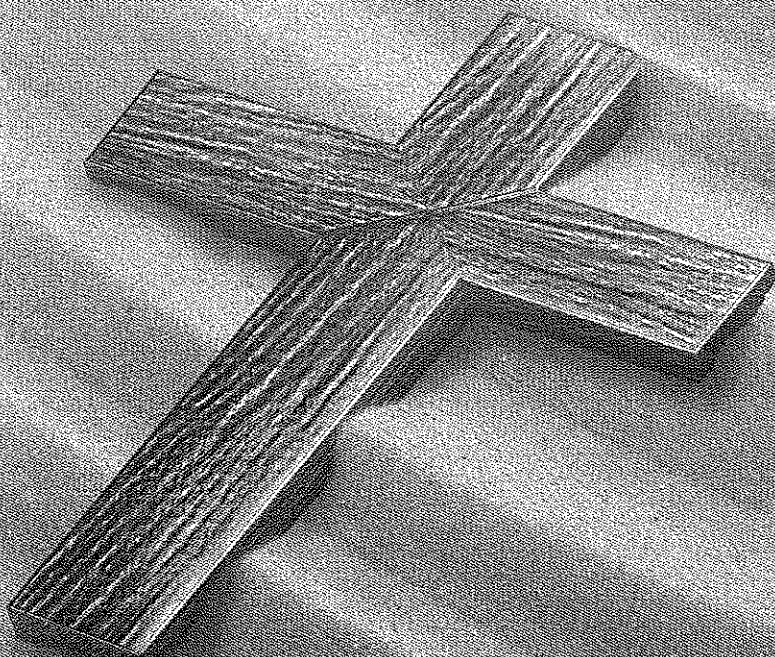

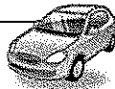
PIANO LESSONS AVAILABLE

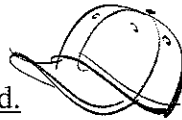

PORTAL TIDBIT



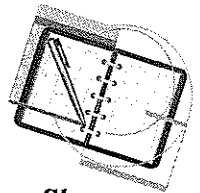
