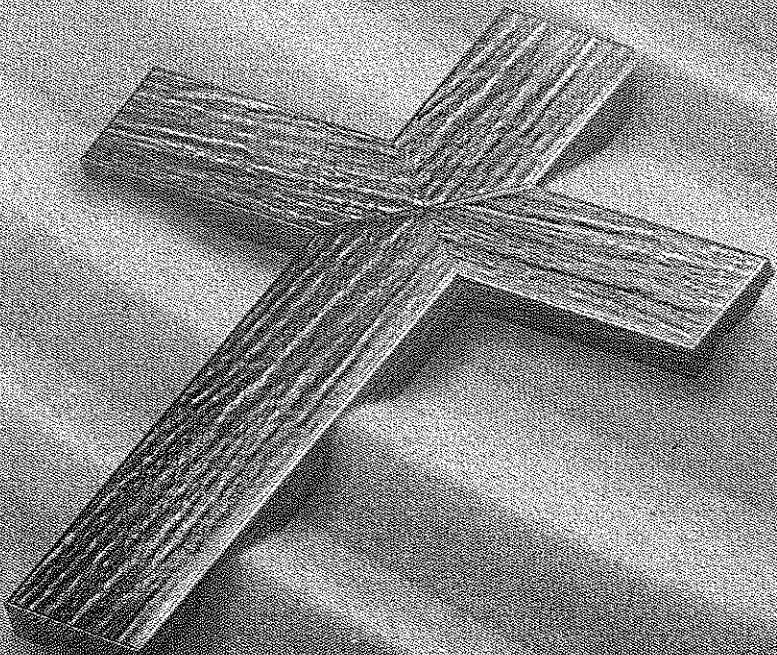

\$5 will pay for a reserved spot on the parking lot AND supper for the ENTIRE family. Remember to bring:

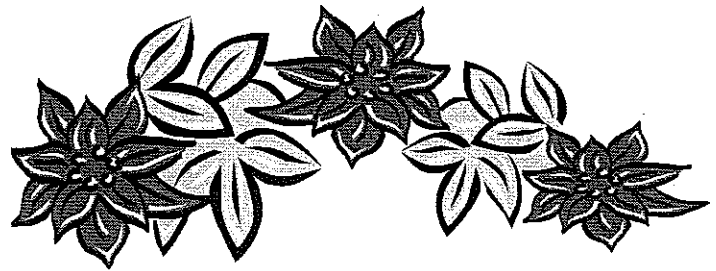
- Treats for the trick-or-treaters – plan for about 150-175 students.

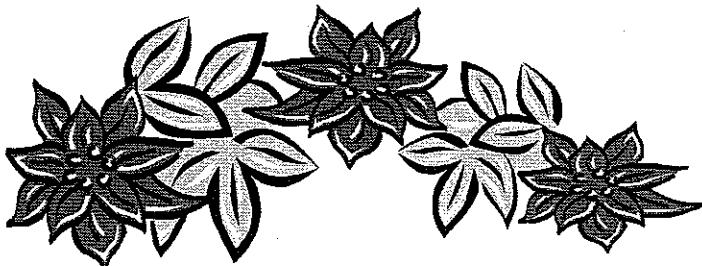

Re: Re-Accreditation of our School System

KCSS received Accreditation in 2002. For those of you not familiar with this, our school works with WRISA, (Wisconsin Religious and Independent Schools Accreditation) a nonprofit organization formed in 1991 by the Wisconsin Council of Religious and Independent Schools to provide non-public schools with an ongoing school improvement process.

WRISA's three phase accreditation process provides school communities with the opportunity to explore every aspect of their school program, receive feedback, and develop a long range plan using the WRISA framework. Once accredited, schools file an annual report documenting compliance with WRISA Standards.

The granting of accreditation to a school is based upon the review of the documentation submitted, substantial compliance with WRISA standards, the development of a comprehensive plan for school improvement, and the favorable recommendation of a visiting team. It also makes schools eligible for grants and gives them credibility.

Every seven years, new studies and surveys must be conducted along with reports submitted regarding specific standards for re-accreditation, which KCSS is up for again in 2008/09. This is a complex project that takes over a year to complete, with surveys you will be asked to fill out, and inspections being conducted in both campuses. Your school being accredited is vital in your child's education and the future of KCSS.

For example, our oldest daughter was a 1997 graduate of KCSS. She was placed in the accelerated math program in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grades and tested into Geometry going into her freshman year at KHS. But at that time KCSS was not accredited so she was not allowed into that class at despite her high test score. Being accredited would have allowed our daughter into advanced classes. They make absolutely no exceptions, so you can see how vital accreditation is. Also, if your children need to transfer to a different school system, their transcripts may not be transferable if KCSS is not accredited.

This is where we NEED your help! Approximately 50 volunteers will be needed to accomplish this project which encompasses ten areas of standards that need to be addressed. Ten volunteer Co-Chair's will over see and record data for each standard, along with additional volunteers within each standard to complete studies and compile them to be submitted for the final report.

Please consider volunteering as a Co-Chair or helping in any capacity you can. Many hands make light work! It is crucial to the present and future of KCSS and especially your children. Volunteering your time to this extensive project will be applied to your volunteer hour's commitment. Thank you for your commitment to Catholic Education.
