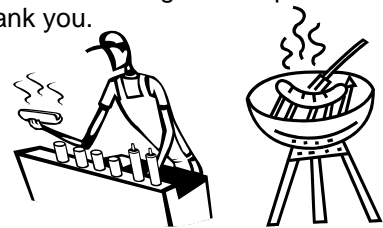

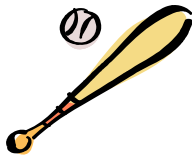
FUNDRAISERS IN APRIL: We will be having 2 fundraisers that you can participate in and they will go towards your fundraising commitment.
