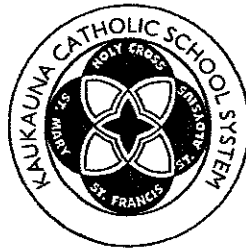

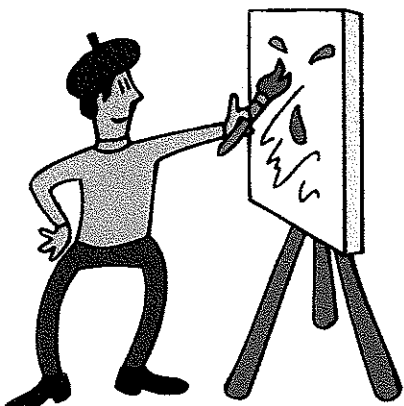
Dear Parents,

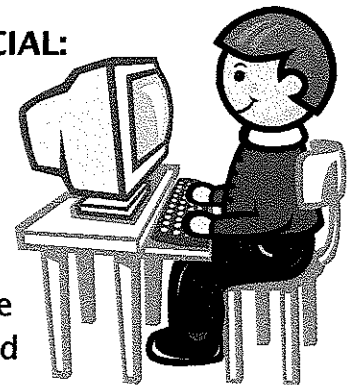
