Please use this time to review proper escape routes in your home. Also, make sure all of your smoke detectors are in working order.

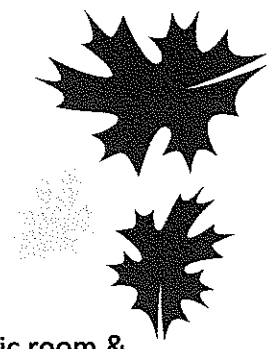

Dear Parents,

I have been reading some great e-mail letters from the teachers to you all. If you have not received an e-mail from your child's teacher and think you should have, please e-mail the teacher. We discovered this week that some e-mails with hyphens were being rejected by our server. We are working to fix this problem. We are in the process of putting the teacher expectations online so they will be accessible to you all year. Some of our teachers have their own websites. Links to their websites can be found on our website.

We have several new things happening this year at Holy Cross. This week I will share about the math programming changes for 7th and 8th grades. Last spring, the chair of the Kaukauna High School Math Department came to meet with our 8th grade math teacher and myself. He expressed a concern that many Holy Cross students were ready for Geometry in the 9th grade, but was unable to take the class because they had not taken Algebra in the 8th grade. Algebra had previously been taught in Accelerated Math only. After some discussion, we agreed to move the majority of our students into Algebra for 8th grade, to teach Pre-Algebra in 7th grade, and to offer a slower Pre-Algebra Course for students who needed more time to grasp the concepts. This group would be able to take up to two years to master Pre-Algebra and would start Algebra in high school. It was very exciting to hear how well our students were doing in their high school Math courses and we are interested in ensuring proper placement for all of our students as they enter high school. Therefore, this year there is no pull-out "Accelerated Math" group. This is because the vast majority of our 7th and 8th grade students are taking "Advanced Math" i.e.: Pre-Algebra and Algebra. We are very excited about the changes and look forward to a great year.

Infinite Campus / Parent Portal

Infinite Campus is the program used by the Kaukauna Area School District (KASD) for grading, homework, and testing information that can be accessed by parents. Holy Cross is, what you might call, a leasing sub-group of this program.

When our parents want to have access to this program, for their children only, they notify the Holy Cross school office. The information required is:

- Parent(s) name
- Children and grades
- e-mail address

We then put the request through to Kaukauna High School (KHS), the database manager. KHS assigns the user names and passwords and then notifies us. Once we receive confirmation, we send a letter to your home with your information.

Notes: * KHS does not change passwords from year to year.
* Only one account is needed for all children per home.

If you would like to utilize this service, please call Sue Vanderloop in the school office at 766-0186.


