

Classroom Expectations

- As you may already know our 6, 7, and 8th grade students only have computer class for 1 hour every week. This means that it is vital for them to make up work when they are absent due to illness, vacations, etc. I give every student one week to make up their work. I am available before and after school as well as during their study times.
- I have also been in contact with the 9th grade computer teacher to be sure our students will be ready when they enter high school. One goal that Xavier has for their students is to be able to type at 40 words per minute (wpm) by the end of 9th grade. This means that our students will need more practice at home in order to increase and then maintain their wpm speeds. Please encourage your student to try typing games online, or practice typing papers at home. I know with all of the technology that our students have been introduced to lately a large majority of my students are typing symbols and short cuts to their words. We need to remind them to spell out all of their words when typing in class.
- Computer classes this year are designed to help your student complete projects and assignments in their regular classroom. This means, at times, they will be getting graded in two subjects for the same assignment.
- Each class period students will be typing and working on projects. They will be graded on their speed/accuracy when typing, their behavior, their effort and comprehension of the material we learned in class.
- Mrs. Roger's expectations will continue into the 7th and 8th grade computer classes.
