NO MORE SECONDS

For the past several years, the term “seconds” has been misinterpreted by many parents and students. Its purpose was to use any leftover food instead of throwing it away. Second helpings were never intended to be a regular part of the school lunch.

Every student is offered a balanced lunch the first time they go through the serving line. There is really no need for them to return to the line. If students are still hungry after they have eaten their lunch, we will be offering different choices of sandwiches to help fill them up.

Remember that the price of the meal only allows for one main entrée and the different sides that meet the requirements of the Department of Public Instruction Dietary Guidelines that our Lunch Program follows.

According to the DPI, obesity in children has increased in the past few years. They are promoting healthy eating habits. It is our responsibility to offer our students a well balanced lunch to help diminish this problem.

The Green Bay Diocese is developing a Wellness Policy for all their schools. It will be put into effect this school year. This is another good reason for KCSS Lunch Program to eliminate “seconds”. This Wellness Policy is mandated by USDA.
