Old Business:

- a. Culver's Night: made \$360 which was put into the mini-grant (Market Day) fund Plan to have a spring night as well. Will check with school to see if there is a specific need to work for—maybe microwaves for the lunchrooms???
- b. Gatorade Day: November 12, no one present to report
- c. Cookie Sale: very successful, should make over \$1400 profit. Plans are to order cookies through the school lunch suppliers to make delivery, pickup and storage easier. Tracy will discuss with Jeanine and the hot lunch coordinators to work this out.
- d. Market Day: had highest sale in November—over \$1100—keep this going.
- e. Teacher Scrip Gift Program: Last day to turn in is this Friday, December 3rd.
- f. Catholic Schools Week: The age appropriate activities have been reserved for Monday, January 31, Wild Air for Preschool-grade 2, need to check on bussing for this age level as the preschool and PreK classes do not attend in the afternoon, so will parents be responsible for taking their child. Also a snack will be served—probably popcorn and water. Cost is \$5.75 per student, need 1:7 ratio for chaperone to student. Chaperones are free. Grade 3-5 will be going to Skate City, the cost is \$227.50 to open the facility, which includes admission for 70 people, both students and chaperones have to pay to skate. Any amount over 70 pays \$3.25 per student. Tracy will call Skate City to see if snacks can be brought in or if we must purchase there. We could provide one drink and a popcorn for all students. (details to be worked on) Grades 6-8 are going to Badger Sports Park, at a cost of \$7 per student. Bussing has been arranged for the KC students already. Cost for bussing is \$79.25 and \$158.50 for the HC kids.
